Pennsylvania, I Stephen Long of the Township of Little  
Britain in the County of Lancaster, Farmer, do hereby  
enter and return That Samuel a Negro Male Child  
the Son of Negro Peggy a Female Slave was born on  
or about the Tenth Day of February in the Year of our  
Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety two, and  
that his said Mother, Peggy was duly entered and registered  
by John Atchison at Lancaster, as a Slave, pursuant to the  
Act "for the Gradual Abolition of Slavery," and that the  
aforesaid Negro Child Samuel is my Property, and liable  
to serve until it shall arrive to the Age of Twenty eight Years  
Witness my Hand the fifteenth Day of June in the Year  
of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety two
