Arthur C. Bining (b. 1893), professor of History at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia, wrote articles and two books on iron and steel manufacturing. Among his writings are <u>History of the Iron and Steel Industry in the United States</u>, <u>Pennsylvania Iron Manufacture in the Eighteenth Century</u> and "The Rise of Iron Manufacture in Western Pennsylvania."
