# JOHN ENMAN COLLECTION Motion Picture Films

## Original (seven 16mm and one 8mm) 100 ft color films made by Dr. Enman

## Film # Description written on film carton by Enman:

- 1. Alicia: Close-ups of some of 400 rectangular ovens, equipment, shaft & tipple of plant just upriver from Brownsville, PA. Some scenes of traffic on adjacent Monongahela River & panorama of entire plant as of May 1967--plant operated until late winter '67. Rectangular ovens rarer than beehive ovens.
- 2. Coke quenching & Oven Loading: Bulk of film shows coke quenching at beehive ovens of Ruane Coal & Coke Co., Fairchance, PA. This is at old Laughead works, built in 1880 and operated for some years by H.C. Frick Coke Co. Latter part of film shows oven loading & close-ups of trunnel holes.
- Leckrone: Panoramic & close-up scenes of beehive plant, in Klondike, once operated by H.C. Frick & before that by Puritan C.&C. Co.. Present tipple, larries, coke machine, conveyor and ovens shown in close-up. Some scenes of nearby company houses. Same plant as on films showing loading, levelling, bricking & unloading of ovens, which were sent [to the State Archives] earlier. Because of jam in take-up mechanism some footage at end of roll has probably been lost. Plant idle but ready for resumed operations when film was made. May '67.
