SAMUEL EVANS COLLECTION, 1752-1918

Papers of Samuel Evans (b. 1823) of Donegal Township, Lancaster County, an authority on local history. He was an apprentice of Isreal Cooper, Quaker builder of Columbia, from 1838-44 and then engaged in building and the lumber business. He was Justice of the Peace and notary in Columbia. The papers include a letter from Horace Greely, 1856; a letter of James Buchanan, 1829; five letters from Thaddeus Stevens, 1854, 1857, 1866; a Simon Cameron letter, 1878; a letter from A. G. Curtin, 1878; a history of the settlement of Columbia; genealogical data on the Evans' family and other families of Lancaster County; and legal papers and accounts.
