This covered bridge would span the mile-wide Susquehanna River to connect the city of Harrisburg with the towns and roads on the western shore. The bridge was also known as the Camelback Bridge due to its shape and construction. Also included is a letter of introduction for Burr addressed to three directors of the bridge company. The papers relate to the construction of the Harrisburg Bridge and include reports of its progress and requests by Burr for additional funds from the company.
