



Situate on the waters of little Clearfield creek including a run called Spruce run about $4\frac{3}{4}$ miles South of the County town, and about $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles West of the mouth of little Clearfield Creek in Shindclamush township, Clearfield County including George Hunters improvement: Containing four hundred and twenty Acres and sixty four perches and allowance &c. Surveyed the 14th of June 1810, in obedience to an Order of the Board of Property dated September 26th 1809. for John Norris; upon which a return of a Survey was made the 17th of June 1785 of 415 Acres &c; in pursuance of a warrant granted Robert Boggs dated the 8th of July 1784 To Andrew Porter Esq^r Charles Trogenulny D.S. Surveyor General

Note. Robert Boggs has no old corners nor lines, all made new since the resurvey.
