



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary's Dated  
the Twenty-third Day of January 1733 there was Surveyed  
to Henry Vernon a Certain tract of Land situate in  
Oley in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup> adjoining to a tract  
of Land belonging to Peter Robeson Beginning at a  
post in the line of said Robeson's Land thence by the same  
North West one hundred & fifty two perches & by land of  
James Thomson the same Course twenty four perches to  
a post thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred &  
forty five perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South East  
one hundred & six perches & by land of John Collins of the same Course Seventy  
perches to a post in the line of said Collins Land thence by Vacant Land  
South West one hundred & forty five perches to the place of Beginning  
Containing One hundred & fifty Acres <sup>1/2 Acre</sup> with the allowance of Six  
per cent
