No. 3. Containing 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ 006 part part of 83 $\frac{1}{2}$ 124 Surveyed — Hart to John Carmichael dated 29th April 1776

No. 4. Containing 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ 005 part part of 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ 144 surveyed 15th Jan^y 1817. Hart to Wm Morrison dated 1st Jan^y 1817

No. 5. is part of No. 3 containing 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ 131 part of 83 $\frac{1}{2}$ 124 Surveyed on Hart to John Carmichael dated 29th April 1776.

No. 6. Containing 22 82 Surveyed 14th Oct 1790 Hart to John Carmichael dated 15th July 1790. All which appears to have been resurveyed and divided for Joshua Morrison & William Morrison in January 1815 & 1817. Examined 31st March 1823
