



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate for the most Part in Maccougy Township and the Remainder in Upper Millford Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania Containing one Hundred and Twenty five acres and 35 perches of Land together with the usual allowance of six percent for Roads That was formerly surveyed By Edward Scull unto Jacob Weier By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries Dated the 29<sup>th</sup> Day of June Anno 1744 - / Then including Twenty Three acres 95 perches more / whereof the above said Tract was ordered by the Secretary to be returned for George Schlegler... and the said Small Tract of 23<sup>ac</sup> etc for Jacob Gertenheir.
