Beginning at a Hickery at a Corner of the Land of the said Shugart Thence North 50 Degrees West by the same and the Land of Hans Witz 100 perches to a Post Thence North 40 Degrees East by Vacant Land 85 perches to a small Black Oak Thence South 50 Degrees East by Vacant Land 100 perches to a Post Thence South 40 Degrees West by the Land of Henry Shugart 85 perches to the place of Beginning Containing Fifty Acres beside the allowance of Six of Cent for Roads
