In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1872 a survey was made on the 5<sup>th</sup> of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Dunbury in the County of Northumberland numbered in the general Plan of said Town Two hundred and thirty seven, and granted to John Stansfield containing in Breadth East and West Sixty feet and in length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet, bounded Westward by Lot number Two hundred & thirty eight, Northward by Gooseberry alley Eastward by Deer Street & Southward by Rackberry Street, as by the general Plan of said Town remaining in the Survey.
