



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Twentythird day of March 1733 Surveyed unto Hans Ulrich Meyer a tract of Land situate in Oley in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a Stone thence By Vacant Land North twenty Degrees East one hundred and six Perches to a Maple tree thence by Vacant Land North seventy Degrees West one hundred and sixty perches to a hickery thence by Vacant Land South twenty Degrees West one hundred and six perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South seventy Degrees East one hundred and sixty perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of six & Cent.
