



A Draught of a survey called, "Prestonpans," on Peters creek in Washington County. Containing 285 acs. 97 ps. strict measure, executed February 24<sup>th</sup> 1786, in consequence of a certificate for 235 Ac<sup>s</sup> granted to J<sup>o</sup> Thompson by the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> appointed by Virg<sup>a</sup> to adjust the claims to unpatented lands in the counties of Monong<sup>a</sup>, York<sup>a</sup> and Ohio, and duly entered with ye County Surveyor as appears from the list of entries transmitted from ye Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup>'s Office.
