



By virtue of a warrant dated 17th ~~September~~ ^{August} 1793. Surveyed 12th Sep-
 tember 1793. to William Baird the above tract of land, situate on the branches
 of a small brook that empties on the East side of the North East branch of
 Susquehanna about half a mile below where it passes the State line be-
 tween the fifty six and fifty seven mile stones in Luzerne County. Con-
 taining four hundred and six acres, and one hundred and twelve perches,
 and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
