



Extract of the Report of the men appointed by the Orphans Court at York to view value and divide the estate of Christian Oyster late of the said County, deceased (to wit) "I certify and we do allot to Christiana Oyster, Youngest Daughter of the said Decedent one certain Lot of Ground, Situate on the East side of Beaver Street in the Town of York marked on the General Plan of the said Town Number Eighty two, containing in Breadth on said Street fifty seven feet and six inches and in length to a twenty feet (~~obliterated~~ ~~obliterated~~ ~~obliterated~~) Beaver Street aforesaid Northward with a Lot of Ground marked on the plan aforesaid Number Eighty one, Eastward with a twenty Feet alley, and Southward with a Lot of Ground marked in the plan aforesaid Number Eighty three which said Lot of ground with the House thereon erected. We do value at the sum of fifteen Pounds."
