



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 15. Day of December  
 Romque Domini 1743. granted to Jacob Moore. The above described Two  
 Tracts of Land Situate in Heidelberg Township in the County of Northampton  
 and Province of Pennsylvania. The one Containing Ten acres and 32 perches  
 of Land with the usual allowance, and the other Containing twenty three acres  
 and 93 perches of Land. Together Thirty Three acres and 125 perches of Land  
 with the usual allowance at six per Cent for Roads, were surveyed for Henry  
 Frie, who had purchased his Right to the same of the said Jacob Moore, and  
 again sold the last mentioned Tract to Charles Ross. The said Henry Frie had also  
 bought of the said Jacob Moore his other Land, joining to the above, and also sold  
 part of to the said Charles Ross. Surveyed on the 19 day of August Annoque Domini
