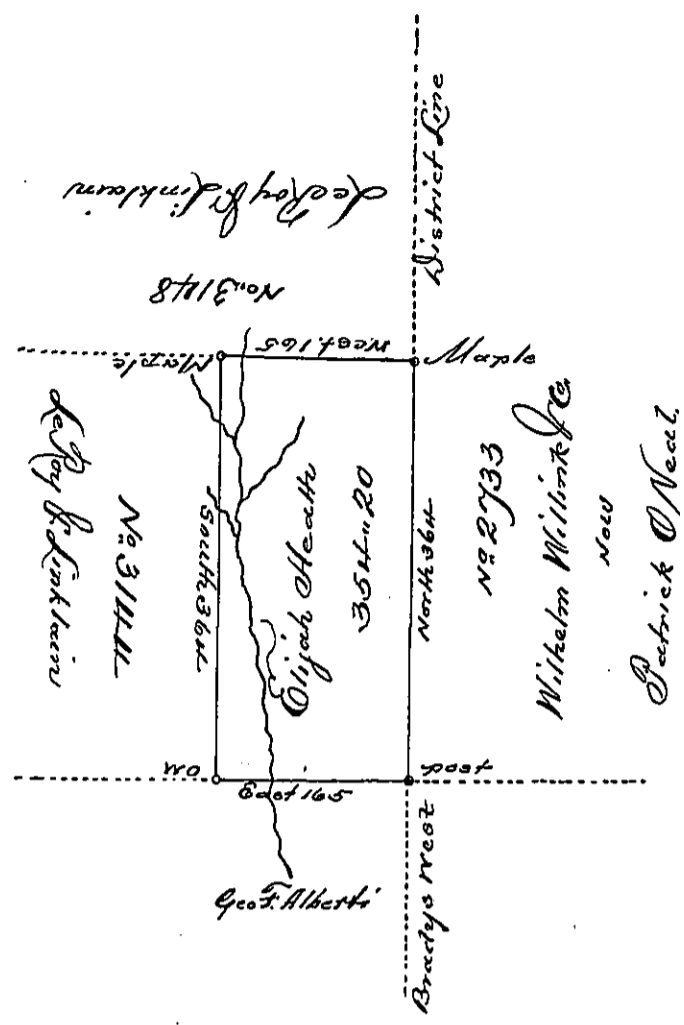

The above described tract of land containing Three hundred and fifty four acres and twenty perches and a rovincial of six per Cent for Roads &c. Situated on the north side of the Clarion River in Bernette Township in the County of Jefferson. And in the last Purchase made of Indians East of the Allegheny River and Chawango Creek. By virtue of a warrant granted to the said Elijah Heath for 340 acres dated at Harrisburgh the 2<sup>nd</sup> of April A. D. 1839
