



By Virtue of a Warr^t from the Commission^r of Property bearing date the 10th day of the second month 1718. Surveyed and laid out unto William Smith a Tract of land in Wrightstown in Bucks County, Beginning at a post in the line of the Town Square being a Corner of the s^d Smith's other Land, from thence extending by the s^d Land South 20 degrees East 290 perches to a post by a small black oak, Then by overplus Land West 6 degrees South 90 perches to a small white oak, Then by John Penquites Land North 6 degrees West 266 perches to a heap of stones in the afores^d line of the Town Square Then by the same North East 26 perches to the place of beginning, Contain^g 96 Acres. Certified under my hand this 25th day of the 12th month 1718.
