



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Max-  
 etawny Township in the County of Berks, but  
 formerly in the County of Philadelphia and Province  
 of Pennsylvania. Containing fifty Seven acres and 22  
 perches of Land with the usual allowance for Roads.  
 That was Surveyed on the 20<sup>th</sup> Day of July Anno 1743 unto  
 Jacob Stutsman In Pursuance of a Warrant from the  
 Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Proprietaries Dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> Day of October Anno  
 1742. The Rights to the Same Tract is now to be conveyed unto Michael Christman  
 formerly Surveyed by Edward Scull, Surveyor  
 Recurveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> Day of May Anno 1763.  
 N.B. this above was Surveyed to Jacob Miller  
 in Right of the Said Jacob Stutsman David Shultz
