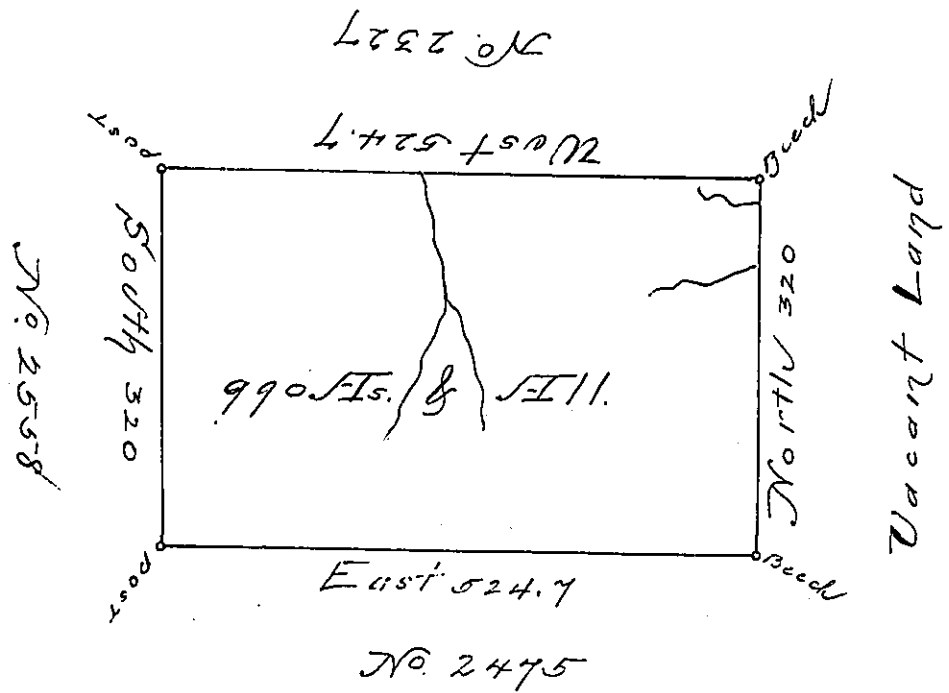

Surveyed July 12<sup>th</sup> 1793 for Wilhelm Willink, Nicolas Van Stafoorst Christian Van Eighen Hendrick Wallenboom and Rutger Jan Schemmelpenninck in pursuance of a Warrant No 2339 bearing date December 12<sup>th</sup> 1792.
