Anno 1753, In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Rudolph Gerrit the 9<sup>th</sup> Oct<sup>r</sup> 1744, The same was afterwards returned either for Adam Wink or Philip Skoll (or Philip Peter Skoll) as forger the paper date now belong to John Hartman.
