



A Plan of a Lot in the Town of York No. 118 (entered in the Plan of the Town in Nov. 1741 for Matthias Cwoensendt and on whom Henry Stertzinger derives Title) containing in Breadth on High Street Sixty five Feet and in Depth to a twenty Feet Alley two hundred & thirty Feet bounded Southward with High Street, Westward with a Lot of Ground now in the Tenure of Joseph Updegraff Northward with a twenty feet Alley and Eastward with a Lot of Ground now in the Tenure of John Gledy, Survey'd for Henry Stertzinger who has improved the same according to the Conditions of settling the Town.
