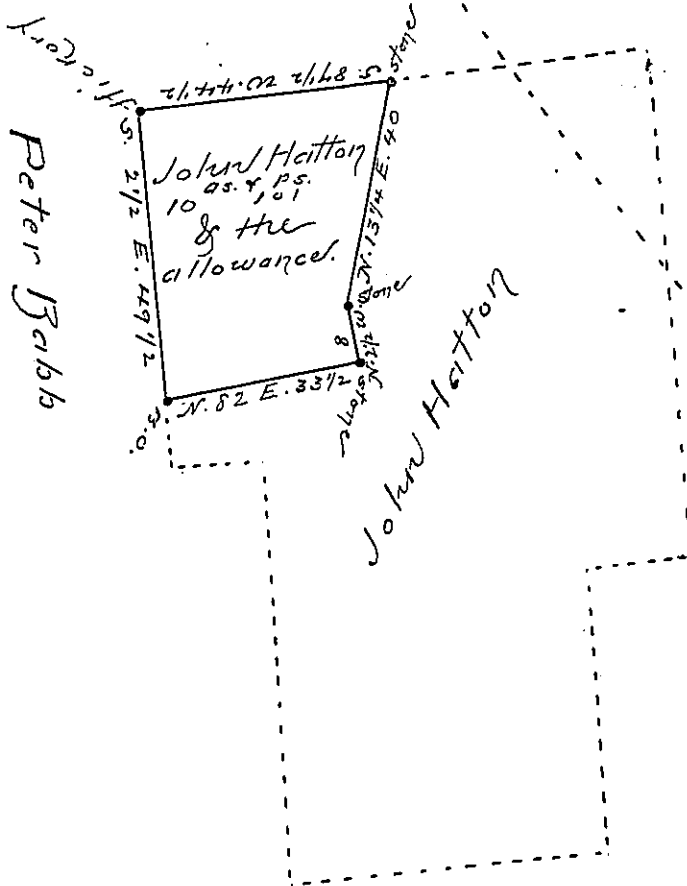


Land Surveyed for the Proprietors
