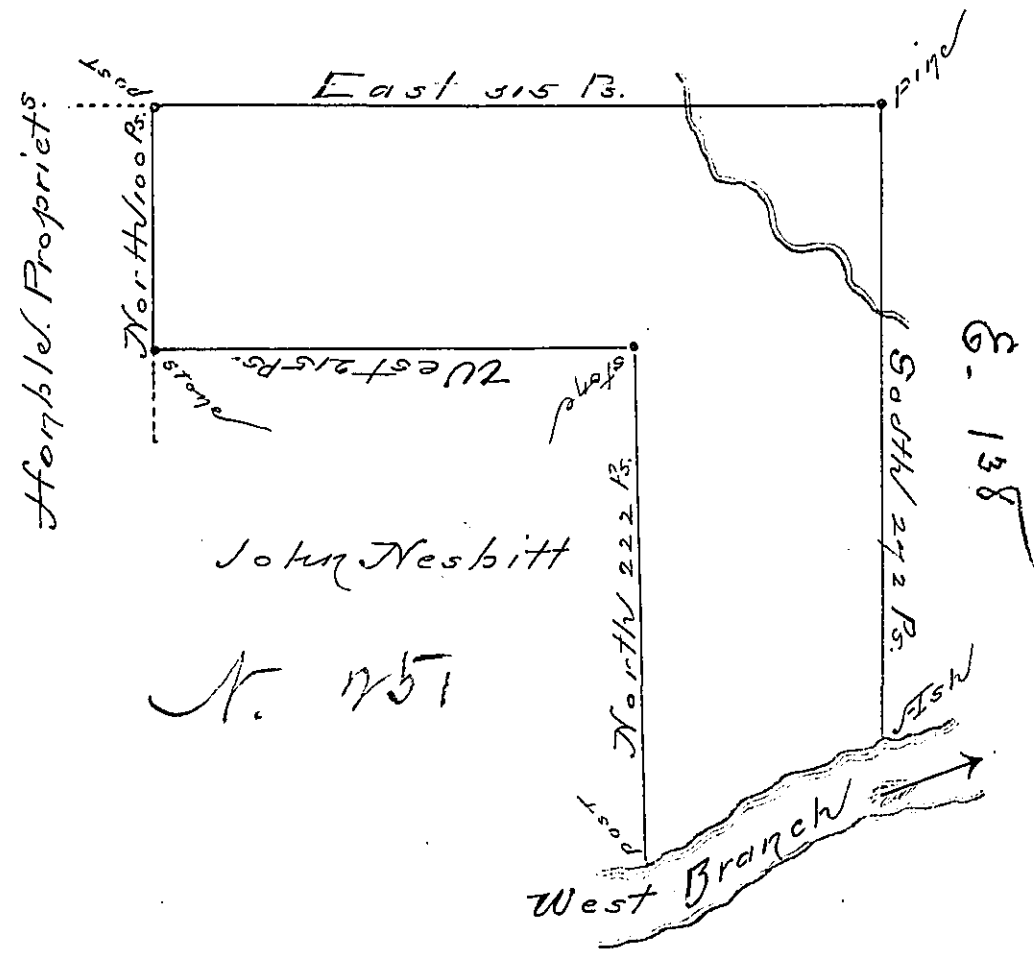


Vacant Land
