



Situate on the Head of the West Branch of the Schuylkill at Six Miles South of the State Line in the last Purchase District No. 11.

Surveyed the second day of August 1793 in Pursuance of a Warrant to Thomas M. Willing No. 3422 Dated the fourteenth day of December 1792 for 1000 Acres.

Containing Eleven hundred acres and the usual allowance of Six P. Ct. for Road &c.
