



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Spring Grove (Being part of a larger Tract of the same name) situate on the Heads of a Run which empties into Stony Creek about three Miles above Conemaugh Old Town about four or five Miles from the Mouth of said Run adjoining Lands of Jacob Mueser and Samuel Hess in Brother Valley Township in the County of Bedford containing three hundred and forty nine Acres & the usual Allowance of six T. Cent for Roads &c.
