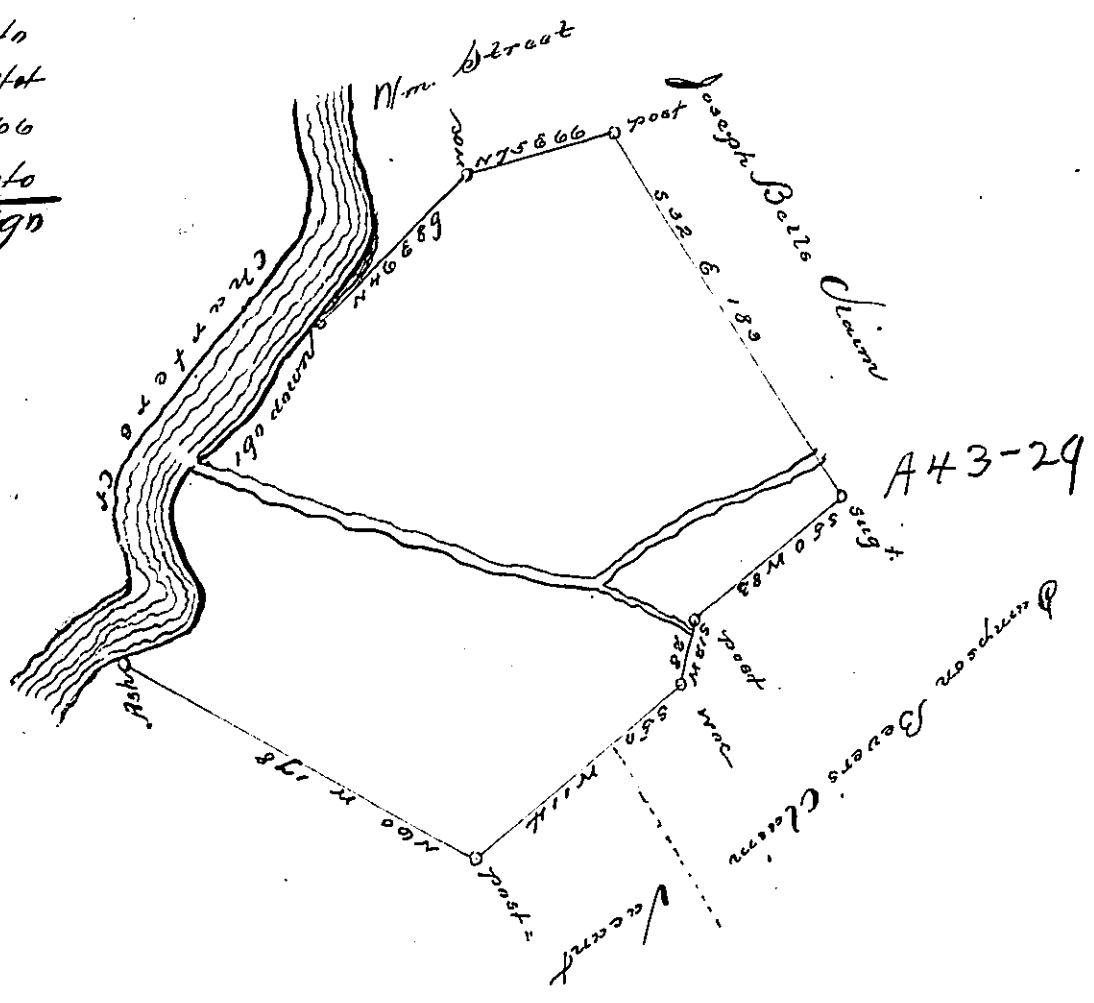

 lowance of 60 Cent for Roads. &c.
