



A Draught of a Tract of land called Morris Town situate on the Westerside of the North East branch of Susquehanna River about a mile above the Mouth of Wyabosing Creek in the County of Northumberland containing two hundred and ninety nine acres & a half besides the usual allowance of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 2<sup>d</sup> Day of October 1773 for Joseph Morris in pursuance of an Order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> April 1769 & numbered 1479
