



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Rodowick Weibel on a certain lot of ground situate in the Town of Dumbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number forty three containing in Breadth East and West on Shamokin Street sixty feet, and in length North and South on Town Street Two Hundred and Thirty feet Bounded Southward by Shamokin Street, Eastward by Town Street Northward by Houlberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number forty four. Returned into the Secretaries Office the 21st day of March 1776 for Peter Graff by Warrant dated same day
