Land situate in Licking Township (unimproved) bounded on the east by vacant land formerly claimed by Peter on the south by G. W. Dunkle on the west by Fox now Moore Painter & Co and the north by the Clarion River containing thirty acres and one hundred & two perches neat measure.
