- N 23 W 25 1/2 H.O.

A Draught of four acres and one hundred and thirty perches of land with six per cent for roads. Situate in Germanagh Township in Keifflin, (formerly, Cumberland,) county, which is part of a tract of land surveyed in pursuance of an order of survey granted to William Cochran dated 4<sup>th</sup> November 1766 and numbered 1805. Said to contain 273<sup>98</sup> 76<sup>00</sup>. The above part resurveyed and struck or marked off 25<sup>th</sup> June 1801. Examined 29<sup>th</sup> January 1811. Note the date of the original survey is not on the original draught, tho' it is official and appears ancient—
