I do hereby certify that a Survey made in Pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel Potter bearing date March 8th 1786 and returned into the Surveyor Generals Office, and recorded in the Books of said Office. That the same Land was surveyed in the year 1770 in Pursuance of an application in the name of Michael Rumberger, and a Patent hath been Issued in Pursuance thereof, and the field notes of said Survey are now in my Office, therefore the Survey made in Pursuance of Potters Warrant has become void, given under my hand this 13th day of Sept 1794.
