 for Jas Gregory & Charles Imhoff in dispute - Gregory claiming by a location in his own name of 1776 and Imhoff by virtue of an Improv^t - Imhoff obtained a judgment of 13th 1/2 in his favor rejecting the location & survey of Gregory - Imhoff by Deed of 20th Oct^r 1768 Conveyed his Improv^t & land held thereby to Hugh Cook, who also by Virtue of a Deed from Jonas Seely dated 19th March 1770 became vested in the right to a 300^{ac} warrant the location of which ~~will~~ includes this survey with the adjoining one and Hugh Cook's right by virtue sundry Conveyances became vested in John Graff (who applies for a Patent this survey with the approbation of the Survey General & Secretary)
