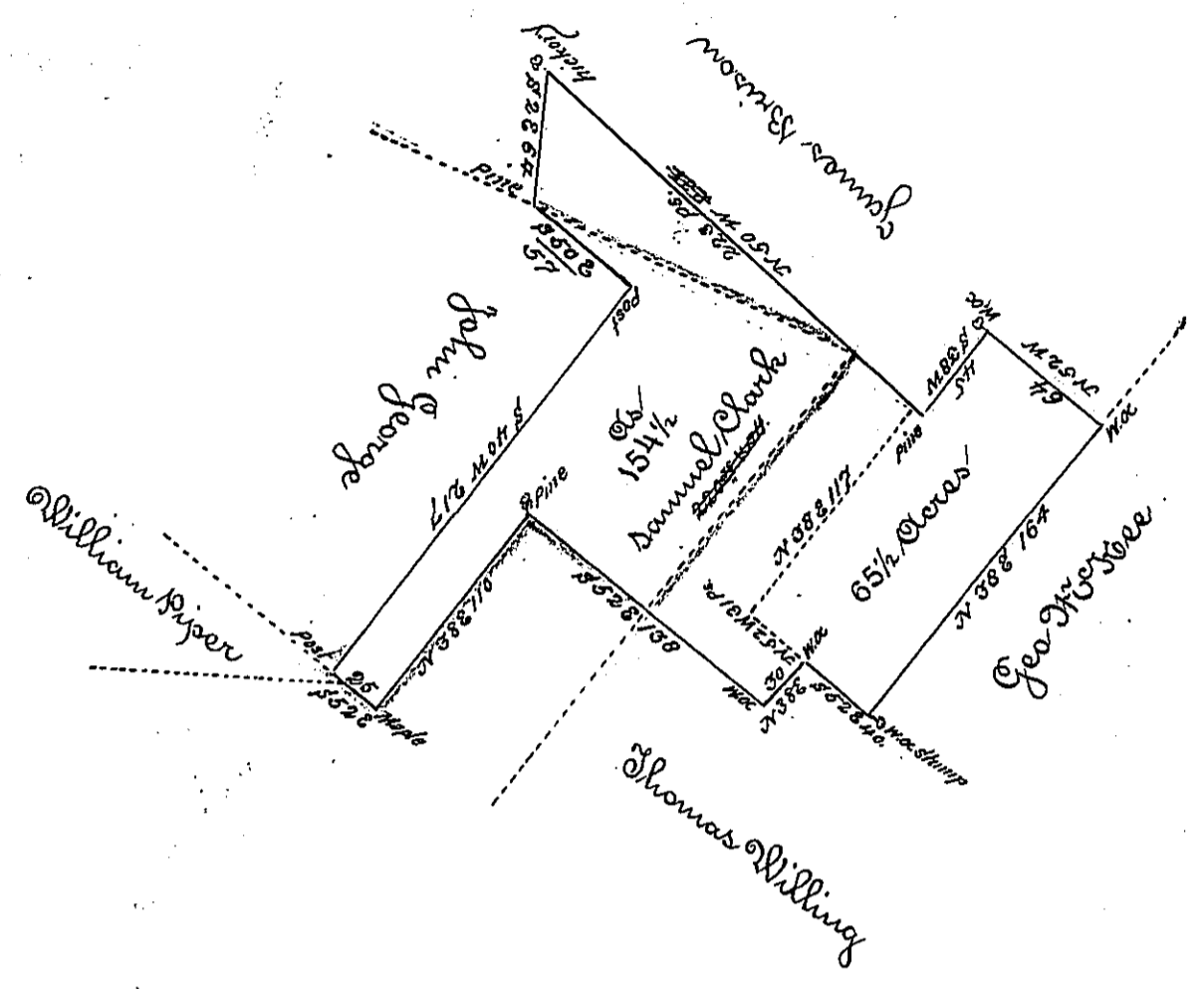

That part marked within the yellow lines is surveyed and Returned for Thomas Smith by virtue of his Warrant bearing date on the 8 Day of January 1798. And that part within the Red lines is surveyed and Returned for John George by virtue of his Warrant bearing date on the 29 Day of November 1774
