

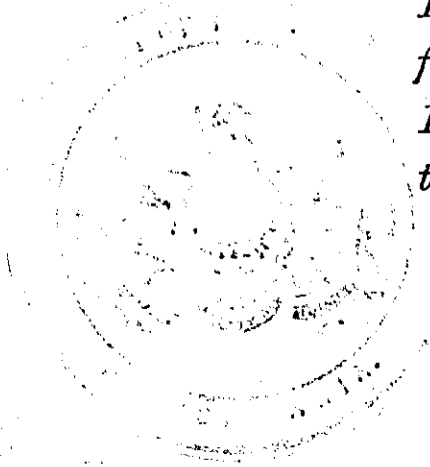
N.B. I find a W^t of 19th Apt to Ernest Sigismund Seidel Vacating the W^t of 17th 43 granted to Geo. Sauerber

By Virtue of two Warrant the one in the Name of George Sauerber dated the fifth day of December 1743 Land there on Survey d. 151 acres and 132 perches and the allowance the other in the Name of Ernest Sigismund Seydel Dated the Nineteenth day of April 1745 Land there on Survey d. 65 acres 29 p. and the allowance (28 acres 51 perches part of 65 acres 29 perches sold unto Ulrich Moon) the Remainder Resurvey'd unto John Robbin Right of the two above mentioned Warrant Except what was sold here to fore The above described Tracts of Lands partly Situate in Epeter and partly Alsace then Phila- delphia County but now Berks Containing in the whole one Hundred Eighty Eight acres and 100 perches and the allowance of Six p Cent
