



A Draft of forty and five perches of land with six per cent for roads situate in Fermanagh township in Mifflin county surveyed 11th November 1814 in pursuance of a Warrant to James Mackey Esquire dated 27th June 1814. Note, all the land in the above draft was cleared, and grain growing in it, at time of survey, and Matthew Taylor claimed it by virtue of a Warrant to David Allen dated, also 27th June 1814 as well as by his purchase of the improvement right dated 4th July 1814.
