



A Draught of a tract of land said to contain 425 1/4 Acres of land with 6 p Cent situate in Milford township Mifflin County Survey? Dec. 21<sup>st</sup> 1796 in pursuance of a Warrant to Thomas Beale dated Febry. 26<sup>th</sup> 1790. Resurveyed Aug. 2<sup>d</sup> 1819 in pursuance of an order of survey to William M<sup>c</sup> Crum dated June 15<sup>th</sup> 1819 and found to contain Four hundred and thirty nine acres & 13 perches with 6 p. Cent.

Notes \* The Ch. & O. appears to have been marked at the time of Joshua Smith's Survey.

The line bearing S. 3 W. 108 is run according to the old marks found on the ground.

The dotted line is laid down according to the courses of the old draughts.
