



A Draught of nine acres and one hundred and fifty seven perches of land with 6 plant foot Roads situate in Derry Township in Mifflin (formerly Cumberland) county, which is part of 164<sup>ac</sup> 69 perches surveyed 14<sup>th</sup> December 1774 in pursuance of an Order of survey to John Early dated 2<sup>nd</sup> August 1766 No. 681, as appears by official papers remaining in my office in Mifflin town in and for said county. Note, the dotted line through the above draft, represents a division made by and for James Dukson & Matthew Kelly. No. 1 James Dukson and No. 2. Matthew Kelly, and the above draft of 9<sup>ac</sup> 157 per. is now the property of Moses Kelly, willed to him by his father, the said Matthew Kelly.
