



Situate on the heads of Bear Dam Run, ^{a branch of Spruce Creek.} formerly in Huntingdon now in Center County containing Two hundred & fifty acres seventeen perches and the usual allowance for Roads surveyed & the interferences taken and laid down ^{by order of the Board} the 12th day of November 1800 in pursuance of a Warrant to Lewis Lewis dated the 13th day of March 1776. The above is the land comprehended in Mr. Woods' incomplete Draft the lines of which was run in August 1784 but not for Lewis Lewis' Warrant.
