



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietors & Commissioners Dated ye 10th Day of the 1718 I survey'd to Daniel Hockfanson a certain Tract of Land on the west side of Bran Sewine scilicet part in the County of Chester & part in the County of New Castle Beginning at a Corner marked Hickery Tree at a Corner of other Land of ye s^d Daniel Hockfanson thence East north East by Vacant Land 176 Perches to a post thence South West by North by ye Land of Aaron Harlan 160 perches to a White oak thence west by ~~the~~ vacant Land 73 perches to a post thence South by the Land of Alexander Grizer and the said Daniel Hockfanson 200 perches to ye Place of Beginning Containing 125 acres with the allowance of six per Cent
