The above Red lined survey represents a tract of land situate in Hamilton Township Franklin County (formerly Cumberland Co. Pa.) surveyed 28<sup>th</sup> July 1753, on Warrant to William H<sup>c</sup> Cord bearing date 24<sup>th</sup> of May 1753

The above tract is covered by a survey made the 16<sup>th</sup> May 1788 on a Warrant to John Bossart dated 22<sup>th</sup> March 1788 & confirmed by Patent 6<sup>th</sup> of June 1795, as represented by the black lined survey which includes some more land than the Original survey of H<sup>c</sup> Cord.

The present owner & occupier is John Bossart Esquire; who acquired his title to the land from W<sup>m</sup> H<sup>c</sup> Cord.
