



Situate on one of the head branches of Roundlick run, a branch of Juniata; and on one of the head branches of Wolfs camp run, a branch of Hills creek; including a very old improvement - on both sides of the great road leading from Somerset to Bedford and surveyed the 11th day of May 1792 by George Woods Esq. then W. S. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to David Husband dated the 30th day of Sept 1784; as appears by the Officially certified draught of John McCleure Esq. W. S. dated 30th Nov 1811, accompanied by his explanatory note, stating that the interference of James Daily's and John McCleure's surveys therewith, as represented by the dotted line; being 57% (leaving only 42 1/2 a/c clear of dispute) happened by inaccuracy in surveying the latter
