



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Haccangy Township in the County of Northampton [formerly Bucks] in the State of Pennsylvania, containing Fifty Acres of Land with the usual allowance for Roads, which formerly was surveyed by Edward Scull for Christian Gorr by Virtue of a Warrant dated on the 17th June Anno. 1745. The same was afterwards resurveyed for him and divided The greatest Part thereof is now belonging to his Grand Son George Gorr Junior and the Remainder to Geo Keibler. Drawn again on the 25th October Anno. 1783.
