



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Blooming Garden situate in the Long Limestone Valley on the path leading from the Bald Eagle's Nest to Standing Stone &c about Eight Miles from said Nest on both sides of about 1800 adjoining and to the southward of Land of Michael Shank and Northward of Jacob Greiter's Land, in Cumberland County: Containing Three hundred and Ten Acres and the usual Allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of October 1770 for Michael Greiter in pursuance of an Order No: 120 Dated the 3<sup>d</sup> Day of April 1769. Now Northumberland County
