



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Blooming Garden situate in the Long Limestone Valley about seven Miles and a half from the Bald Eagles Nest; on both sides of Trout Run, adjoining and southward of Land of John Shank and Northward of Michael Greiter's Land in Cumberland County Containing Three hundred and Ten Acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 23^d Day of October 1770 for Michael Shank in pursuance of an Order No. 1732 Dated the 3^d Day of April 1769 —
