



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the encamping Place situate on Wills Creek about a Quarter of a Mile below the Beaver Dams adjoining below John Shaw & adjoining and above William Robinson in Cumberland Township in the County of Bedford containing two hundred & twenty three Acres and the usual Allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c surveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> Days of November 1774 for James Barclay in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of Sept. 1762. by
