



A Draught of a Lot of Ground situate on the East Side of Queen Street in the Town of Reading in the County of Berks, containing in Length the East & West two hundred & thirty feet, & in Breadth North & South sixty feet, bounded to the North by Lot No. 276 to the East by a twenty feet Alley, to the South by Lot No. 280, & to the West by Queen Street aforesaid, marked in the general Plan of said Town No. 277. Returned into the Surveyor General's Office the 15th February 1768, for Mordecai Lincoln & Joseph Davis.
