



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 28th Day of March Anno. 1749. granted to Henry Cobers alias Confer. The above described Tract of Land Situate in Weisenburgh Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania: Containing ninety one Acres and 26. perches of Land together with the usual allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. — as also another small ^{tract} ~~was~~ surveyed from the Land late of Valentine Thicks now Melchior Seitz, Containing Three Acres and one half Acre with the usual Allowance, which are to be deducted out of the said Valentine Thicks Draught, and to be added to the said Henry Confer, Draught. So that the whole amounts to ninety four Acres and 106. Perches of Land with the usual allowance — Surveyed for the said Henry Confer (alias Cobers) on the 15th Day of May Anno. 1755.
