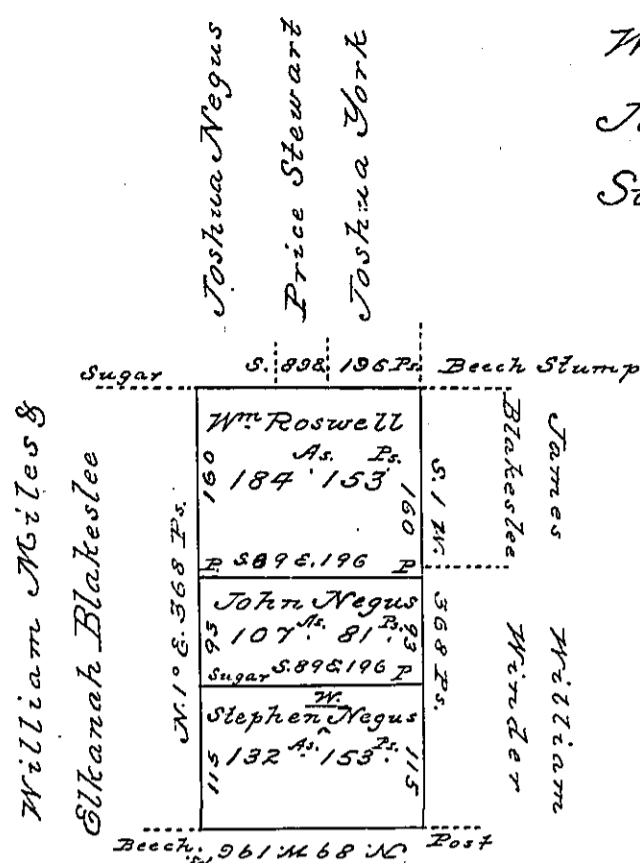

In pursuance of the Settlement of Shadlock Negus begun about the 1800, was Surveyed on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 1837 the above described tract of land containing 425 Acres 48 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. situate in Bloomfield Township Crawford county (The North 184 acres 153 perches having been surveyed for William Roswell The middle 107 acres 81 perches for John Negus, and the South 132 acres 153 perches for Stephen Negus, agreeably to the above plot)
