



Draught of a Survey Made the 20th day of July - A.D. 1843, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Nathaniel Plumer (for 50 Acres) bearing date the 7th day of January 1793, Situate in Lower St. Clair Township, Alleghany County, Containing nine Acres and eighty Two perches and allowance of Six per cent. Surveyed at the instance of William Allen who is now in the possession of the same.

Note. The part A. is described in the Warrant and is now in the possession of Wm. Eddy under James May and contains twenty three Acres & allowance
